



Lightning Policy for Club Practices

Weather Bug app or another approved app by the club will be downloaded by at least one designated staff member for both Tatum Ridge and Twin Lakes and monitored if there is inclement weather in the area.

- If a staff member feels the area is unsafe then he or she should clear the fields.
- **ALL** players, parents, and staff should be evacuated of play and go into a metal, covered vehicle.
- The area in front of concession stand, the picnic areas, and pavilions are not areas that are safe from lightning strikes.
- If a vehicle is not available then players will be instructed to go into the meeting room (Twin Lakes only), concession stand or equipment room (Tatum Ridge only).
- The 30-30 rule will be followed before players will be allowed back onto the field: The 30-30 Rule is an easy way to determine the threat of lightning in your area: 30 Seconds: Count the seconds between seeing lightning and hearing thunder. If this time is less than 30 seconds, lightning is a threat. ... 30 Minutes: After hearing the last rumble of thunder, wait 30 minutes before leaving shelter.
